


## Questions 1-1 Meetings – Digital Exam

### A The Solution

Answer:

Turnitin has a standard class/assignment folder structure. An instructor or student (depending on how the instructor's set-up preferences) can upload a paper to an assignment via a simple file upload. On an assignment there are various bespoke settings you can add, including a start/end/post grade date.

Turnitin integrates with a large number of learning platforms (CMSs / LMSs / VLEs / SISs). Several have partnered with Turnitin for broad use within the Turnitin community. [Partner Integrations](#) are available to institutions that purchase a Turnitin license with integrations enabled.

Turnitin also offers a LTI tool - fully compliant with the IMS LTI 1.0 and 1.1 standards - for incorporating OriginalityCheck, Grademark, and PeerMark into LTI-compliant applications. Our solution provides a digital feedback solution that assists with plagiarism detection, grading and providing intuitive feedback.

- a) Prepare: Turnitin is a comprehensive cloud-based solution and submissions can be made by instructors or students, via the website or through an integration. Turnitin supports single file upload or multiple/zip file upload. Each instructor and student has an account with Turnitin which will allow individual and personalised feedback.
- b) Conducting: Following the completion of the exam Turnitin would be available for students to upload and submit their completed answers.
- c) Examine: Instructors, students and administrations will have access to different areas of the exam and the feedback. We have a clear set of guidelines in place for correct use of the system. We are able to integrate with other LTI compliant systems for a strong support network across the whole process. Students are able to submit their exam following completion and instructors have almost-instant access to commence grading.
- d) Explanations and appeals: Access to the class including the exam submission and the feedback is available as long as the class is active. The time limit in this is defined by the administrator and instructor. Full digital feedback including notes and the original submission is available during this time.
